Hostel Overview

Welcome to Bharati Vidyapeeth Educational Campus Hostel

At Bharati Vidyapeeth Educational Campus Hostel, we strive to create a safe, comfortable, and vibrant living environment for our residents. Our hostel is home to a diverse group of students, fostering a culture of mutual respect, learning, and personal growth

I. Accommodation and Facilities

We offer clean, spacious, and well-furnished rooms, available in shared occupancy. Each room is equipped with essential amenities such as Bed, Wardrobe/Locker, Study table and chair, Fan, Tube lights, Attached/Common Bathroom. Common areas (Mess/Dining Hall, Reading rooms, TV Hall & Well Equipped GYM) are designed for relaxation and foster community interaction. Hostel Building electricity is supported with back-up generator. Guest rooms and Parking facility for the vehicle is present.

- ✓ **24/7 Security:** The safety of our residents is our utmost priority, ensured by round-the-clock security personnel and surveillance systems (CCTV surveillance, Security guards, Face Attendance System).
- ✓ **Nutritious Meals:** Our mess provides (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) wholesome, hygienic, and tasty food, catering to diverse dietary requirements (e.g., "Nutritious and delicious vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals, North Indian and South Indian cuisine"). We facilitate the daily information pertaining to meals through Mess Notice boards.
- ✓ **Cleanliness:** Regular housekeeping maintains high standards of cleanliness across all facilities, including restrooms and common areas.
- ✓ **Laundry Service:** On-site laundry facilities are available for the convenience of all residents but for this residents have to pay separately.
- ✓ **Recreation:** A common room with indoor games, TV, and reading materials helps students unwind. Outdoor sports facilities promote a healthy lifestyle.
- ✓ **Medical Facility:** There is a provision of First Aid Kit and on call doctor facility (If applicable) at the hostel. In Campus 24/7 950 bedded multispecialty hospital is available.

II. Admission Process:

- A student who has been admitted to Bharati Vidyapeeth's College/Institute will alone be eligible to apply for admission to Hostel.

- Admission will be granted by the Management at its discretion.
- Admission will be confirmed only after the student has paid hostel fees and deposit and submitted a copy of the Bank Challan (Office Copy) / Online Payment Receipt in the Hostel office. Hostel year will be from 1st June to 31st May.
- Admission to the hostel will be valid only up to 31st May of the Current academic year.
- Student desire of continuing admission in the hostel for the next year will have to follow the same procedure as prescribed for first admission to the hostel.
- Admission to hostel cannot be claimed as a matter of right.
- For Readmission a student will have to apply for admission before 31st May of each year. A student failing to apply for readmission will forfeit his claim on the seat in the hostel.
- Identity Card of hostel will be issued within 10 days after hostel admission.
- Identity card must be presented on demand.
- It is mandatory for every student residing in the hostel to complete face attendance daily as per the given schedule in the evening.
- While vacating the hostel, you must Deposit your hostel ID Card to hostel office, otherwise hostel deposit will not be refunded.
- Hostel fees can be paid both offline and Online:
- The Receipt of the paid fees should be submitted in the hostel office and student copy should be carefully retained by the student till he gets final receipt of fees and deposit from the hostel office.

II) Cancellation of Hostel admission and refund of admission fees and deposit

1) Cancellation of admission:

The student desire of cancelling hostel admission will have apply in his/her own handwriting to the Warden through the Principal of the concerned college.

2) Refund of hostel fees:

The fees once paid are not refundable except under certain special circumstances as follows-

- a) If the student cancel his/her admission in the college or in the hostel.
- b) If the college Principal cancels admission of the student on technical ground (s)

3) Deduction of fee and charges on cancellation of admission:

If the admission is cancelled after confirmation within

- A. 15 days - 20 %
- B. 15 days to 30 days - 25 %
- C. After 30 days - No refund.

- Note:**
- 1. The student will have to produce Bank Challan/online payment receipt to claim refund.
 - 2. Claim for refund will be valid if made within six months from the date of cancellation of admission.
 - 3. Admission fee & Prospectus Fee is not refundable.

4. Refund of Deposit:

- 1. The deposit will be refundable only after obtaining the no dues certificate from the college as well as from the hostel at the end of internship.
- 2. The refund of deposit will be made by NEFT.
- 3. Those who are not willing to stay in hostel should inform office on or before 31st May and vacate hostel on or before 31st May otherwise the deposit will be forfeited.

III) Regarding stay in the hostel room-

- 1. Allotment of room to the students will be done by the Warden after confirmation of the admission in the hostel.
- 2. Allotment once done will ordinarily remain unchanged throughout the year. However, the Warden will have the right to make necessary changes in the allotment of the room during the year and the change made by the Warden will be binding on the students.

Students will not change his/her room without the prior permission of the Warden.

- 3. A student should occupy his room within 7 days from the date of allotment. If he / she fails to do so, his/her room allotment is likely to be cancelled by the Warden and the Hostel fees paid by him will not be refunded.
- 4. Before occupying the room a student should produce medical fitness certificate from Bharati Hospital.
- 5. Students will have to use their own locks for their room and lockers.
- 6. Students will be provided with a cot, table, chair and a locker. After allotment of the room by hostel authority, each student will have to submit the report of the furniture and the equipment's have been received by him / her Similarly, the student will have to hand over the furniture and equipment's received by him / her at the time of leaving the room.
- 7. A student will use his/her own bedding, bed sheets.

8. Student will have to keep his/her room clean, neat and tidy and should always be careful in its maintenance. They should not throw rubbish things inside or outside the rooms.
9. Students should not use in his/her room electrical appliances like Radio, TV, Hot Plates, Electric Irons, any; additional fan, freeze etc. without written sanction by the warden and on additional charges as prescribed.
10. Students should stay in their rooms between
 - a. Boys-9.00p.m. to 6.00 a.m.
 - b. Girls-8.00p.m. to 6.00 a.m.
11. 11. Restricted access for outsiders. Access permitted with permission only 5pm to 6pm on week days
On Sunday - 10 a.m to 11 a.m & 4 p.m to 5 p.m
Venue - Guestroom available in each hostel.
12. Attendance of the students in the room/hostel is compulsory at the time when the roll is called by the Warden every day at 9.30 p.m. or at the time fixed by the Warden.
13. The students will have to compulsorily mark their attendance through Face screening machine.
14. For permission to remain absent for the roll call or for going outstation or for staying with relatives and friends in the city, a student should apply in writing to the Principal of the college and hostel warden, two days in advance except in emergency and get his/her permission. Such permission will be given only twice in a month.
15. Students should switch off the lights, fans when not required in failure of which they will be liable for fine. So also, students should not disturb the privacy of anyone else by entering into other's rooms or using their things without permission.
16. Students will have to vacate the rooms immediately within two days after their annual examinations are over. If they desire to stay in the hostel during the vacation period, they will have to apply in writing to the Chief Warden in this regard will be final.
17. If the occupant of the room is found not residing in the hostel room continuously for more than seven days without a prior permission of the Warden / Warden his / her room will be considered as vacant and the seat will be allotted to others. The fees will not be refunded under these circumstances.
18. Students will have to inform in writing to the Warden for leave or absentee with prior permission of the Principal.
19. In case the student who remains absent for more than three days without the permission of the Warden, the Principal of his / her college will be informed

accordingly and suitable disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.

20. The Student will have to apply in a prescribed form to the Warden for going out during night for genuine reasons. Such permission will be granted by the Warden only once in a week with the written recommendation of the Principal.

IV) Rules of General Discipline:

- 1) Students should behave in such a manner that the atmosphere in the hostel remains calm and conducive to studies and leading to the cultural and moral development of the inmates.
- 2) Students should take utmost care to keep their rooms and the hostel premises neat and clean.
- 3) Prior permission of the Warden is necessary for arranging any function, lecture, excursion, get-together or to start any activity in the hostel premises. The decision of the Warden for giving permission will be final.
- 4) Students will have to report to the hostel authority about any untoward happening such as theft, cheating, accident, sudden sickness etc.
- 5) The students are advised not to keep valuable articles or cash in their rooms. If they do so it will be entirely at their own risk. They are further advised to lock their rooms with sturdy locks and deposit cash with Bharati Sahakari Bank. Student should take care of their personal belongings. Hostel authorities will not be responsible for any loss or theft of such things.
- 6) If it is found that any unauthorized person or guest is staying in the hostel room without the permission of Warden, the inmate/inmates of the room are liable for disciplinary action and fine.
- 7) The amount of hostel fees and mess charges for the next year will have to be paid before 31st May.
- 8) If any inmate of the room is absent for more than two consecutive days from the room it will be the duty of other inmates to inform about him/her to the Warden of the hostel.
- 9) If any student who has taken admission to the hostel but does not stay in the hostel will be liable for punishment such as instant cancellation of his/her admission from the hostel. In that case no amount of hostel fees and mess charges paid by the student will be refunded.
- 10) Student suffering from injury or sickness should immediately report the matter to the Warden and seek help from Bharati Hospital.

- 11) It is recommended that the student should take medical treatment in Bharati Hospital as they will be provided medical treatment with concession. However, students wishing to be treated elsewhere are free to do so under intimation to the Warden.
- 12) Students will have to remain present for flag hoisting on 15th August and 26th January.
- 13) Vehicles, if any, belonging to the students will have to be parked only at the parking place. The vehicles will have to be parked at the owner's risk.
- 14) Students should not drive vehicles in the college campus or off the campus at a speed more 30 km. per hour. Three or more should not seated while riding two wheeler.
- 15) Students should not unnecessarily loiter in the verandas, passages and cause disturbance to others. Perfect silence should be maintained. Shouting, singing, whistling is strictly prohibited.
- 16) Smoking and consuming alcoholic drinks are strictly prohibited in the hostel and college Premises.
- 17) Students shall not bring or use crackers, hand bombs or any explosive articles in the hostel and college premises. It may cause danger to life property or both.
- 18) Students should take almost care to see that no damage is caused to the hostel building, furniture, electric and sanitary fittings and any other equipment's in the hostel premises. The Cost of loss caused will be recovered from the students.
- 19) Students should not play radio, transistor, record player or any other musical instrument in the hostel premises.
- 20) Pasting Posters or paintings on the walls and writing anything on wall and doors in the hostel rooms or in other parts of the hostel building or in the sanitary block is strictly prohibited.
- 21) Students will have to make entry in the register kept at the entrance of the hostel while going out or coming in.
- 22) Talking loudly, sitting unnecessarily anywhere in the campus / hostel premises, chewing pan parag, tobacco, smoking cigarettes, coming in the hostel, misbehaving with the hostel staff, late coming in the other activity harmful to the interest of the hostel inmates and causing damage to hostel property is strictly prohibited and will be viewed very seriously and strict disciplinary action will be taken against those who are involved in such activities.

- 23) Students shall take meals in the hostel mess attached to their hostel. Tiffin's are not allowed in the rooms from outside and even from hostel mess.
- 24) Students will have to pay for any damage or breakage caused to the hostel property by them.
- 25) While leaving the hostel the student should submit the clearance certificate from the college and the hostel office, for getting refund of the deposit.
- 26) Students should behave politely and properly with the Warden/Staff Members of hostel.
- 27) Strict disciplinary action will be taken against any student if found ragging or torturing any student mentally or physically. Student if found to be misbehaving will be expelled with immediate effect.
- 28) All occupants of the hostel must always keep handy with them the hostel identify card and must show on demand to security guard on duty/competent authority.
- 29) Parents of the students are advised to nominate if necessary, only one local guardian for their wards.
- 30) All occupants of the hostel must take their food in the mess attached to that hostel. Change of mess will not ordinarily be permitted.

Note: The occupants of the hostel will be subject to disciplinary action for any act of any indiscipline, within/outside the hostel, on the campus and off the campus. The authorities of the hostel reserve the right to take suitable disciplinary action such as remove/dismissal from the hostel or cancellation of admission in the hostel.

V) Prohibition

Following activities are strictly prohibited in the hostel and college campus.

- 1) Talking loudly/Making a noise.
- 2) Sitting unnecessarily anywhere meaninglessly in campus/hostels/spitting.
- 3) Smoking cigarettes, chewing pan/pan parag/tobacco etc.
- 4) Comings in hostel in drunken state or drinking/keeping liquor in hostel.
- 5) Students should, not talk loudly on cell phone in room or in hostel premises.
- 6) The festivals like Holi, Rang Panchami etc. will not be permitted to play in rooms or in hostel premises.
- 7) The management of the hostel shall be very strict to curb any activity leading to ragging, fighting and abusing others under the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Prevention Act 1999 and very strict action will be taken against defaulters. The

students engaged in ragged in ragging activities shall immediately be expelled from the hostel and the, college/Institute, (he/they will be permanently debarred from the roll of the institution concerned) The hostel fees, the deposit and the College/Institute fees etc. of Such students shall be forfeited and the Chief Warden/ Warden/ Warden

/Head of the Institution in this respect shall be final and binding on the student and his/her parents. (Attention of the students/parents is drawn to special annexure on " The Rules Prohibiting Ragging" on page no. 14)

- 8) Any kind of firearms or any lethal articles dangerous to the lives of others must not be kept by students.
- 9) No girls will be permitted to enter into the boy's hostel and vice-versa.
- 10) Misbehavior with hostel staff.
- 11) Quarreling with each other.
- 12) Late coming in the hostel (without permission)
- 13) Damage to hostel property.
- 14) Standing in front of hostel main door, in passages, staircases etc.
- 15) Taking meals in other mess.
- 16) Improper and misuse of telephone.
- 17) Pasting posters or paintings on the walls of hostel rooms and doors.
- 18) Playing out-door games in the hostel.
- 19) Disturbance to other students.
- 20) Cooking in the room
- 21) Changing allotted room and cot without prior permission from hostel authority.
- 22) Writing on walls in the room or elsewhere.

In all above matters the decision of the Chief Warden/Warden/Principal/Diwarden shall be final and binding on the students. The students will strictly adhere to the rules of discipline framed by the college and the hostel authorities from time to time.

The management and hostel authority reserves the right to modify the above rules/ regulations from time to time as per requirements, if deemed necessary without notice.

Dispute arising if any, is subject to Sangli jurisdiction only.

MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999

No.Sankima 1098/(133/98) UNI3. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 1 of the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 (Mah. XXXIII of 1999), the Government of Maharashtra hereby appoints the 1st day of June 1999 to be the date on which the said Act shall by order and in the name of the Government of Maharashtra

In pursuance of clause (3) of the constitution of India, the following translation in English of the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 (Mah. XXXIII of 1999), is hereby published under the authority of the Governor.

MAHARASHTRA ACT NO. XXXIII OF 1999

(First published, after having received the assent of the Governor in the " Maharashtra Government Gazette", on the 15th May, 1999)

An Act to prohibit ragging in educational institutions in the State of Maharashtra
WHEREAS it is expedient to-enact a special law to prohibit ragging in educational institutions in the State of Maharashtra. It is hereby enacted in the Fifteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows-

1) Short title and commencement

- 1) This Act may be called the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999.
- 2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint.

2) Definition

In this, Act, unless the context otherwise requires

- a) "Educational institution" means and includes a college, or together institution by whatever name called, carrying on the activity or imparting education their in (either exclusively or among other activities); and includes an orphanage or a boarding home or hostel or a tutorial institution or any other premises attached there to.
- b) "head of the education institution" means the Vice-Chancellor of the University, Dean of Medical Faculty, warden of the Institution or the Principal, Headmaster or the person responsible for the management institution and includes.
 - i) testing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to, such student or
 - ii) Asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary Couse, willingly, do.

3) Prohibition of Ragging

Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.

4) Penalty for Ragging.

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any education institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

5) Dismissal of student

Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.

6) Suspension of student

- 1) Wherever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian, or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action.
- 2) Where, on enquire by the head of the educational institution, it is proved that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received under sub-section(1), he shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complain tee.
- 3) The decision of the head of the educational institution that the student has indulged in ragging under sub-section (1), shall be final.

7) Deemed abetment

If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to take action in the manner specified in section 6 when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence of ragging and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section 4 power to make rules.

- 8) 1) The State Government may by notification in the Official Gazette, amend rules for carrying out all or any of the purposes of this Act.
- 2) Every rule made under this Act shall be laid, as soon as may be, after it is made, before each House of the State Legislature, while it is session for total period of thirty days, which may be comprised in one session or in two or more successive sessions, and if, before the expiry of the session in which it is so laid or the session immediately following, both house agree in making any modification in the rules or both houses agree that the rule should not be made, and notify such decision in the Official Gazette, the rule shall from the date of publication of such notification, have effect only in such modified form or be no effect, as the case may be; so however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done or omitted to be done under that rule.
